# WHAT IS THE ARROWSMITH COMMUNITY JUSTICE SOCIETY

The Arrowsmith Community Justice Society is a community organization whose purpose is to administer a Community Dispute Resolution process which promotes conferencing as a resolution and peacemaking mechanism for conflict in the community. Trained volunteers are utilized to accomplish the above objectives.

## WHAT IS COMMUNITY DISPUTE RESOLUTION?

The Community Dispute Resolution process is a gathering of concerned parties. The goal is to create a safe place to discuss a conflict, how it has affected the parties and to bring healing and, possibly a resolution, to the participants. This community dispute resolution process is available to individuals and groups in our community at no charge.

The community dispute resolution process is:

- Organized and led by trained facilitators.
- Held in a neutral community location
- A safe environment for all participants to express how they have been affected by the conflict.

# CONFIDENTIALITY

The process is confidential between the facilitating team and the participants. Statistics of conferences and their outcomes will be tracked and recorded by the Society for on-going evaluation of the program.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Anyone experiencing differences or conflicts to be resolved.
- All parties must be willing to participate in the process.

- A safe place to talk about how the incident has affected you.
- An opportunity to understand the other party's feelings
- An opportunity to participate in the resolution of the conflict.
- An increased possibility of receiving closure.
