CONFERENCE:	 Your presence here is voluntary and you are free to leave at any time.
Offender's Name	 If you choose to leave before you sign an agreed upon contract, the matter will revert to Cst for further action.
	 However, by participating and by complying with the agreement this matter will be finalized.

GUIDELINES	 * To this end, I ask you to: 1. Share your thoughts and feelings regarding this matter, 2. Respect other people's thoughts and feelings, which will be shared in this circle.
	* Does everyone agree to these guidelines?
	 In order to stay focused on the matters at hand, I request that everyone turn off their electronic devices.
OFFENDER(S)	* has admitted his/her role in this matter and his/her willingness to take responsibility for his/her unlawful behaviour. We'll start by asking him/her to tell us what happened on?

- * What were you thinking before....
- * Tell us about your arrest.....
- * What has been happening since this incident?
- * Who has been affected? (Anyone else?)
- * How have you been affected?
- * What are you thinking now?
